

# **Church School Classes**

## **Children**

Classes are offered for children, nursery through high school, every Sunday. This fall children will learn about Moses, the story of Exodus, wilderness wonders, and how God guides, provides, and builds communities. Stories about Jesus and the disciples will help the children to understand how God is part of their own lives.

## **Adults**

**Young Adults Class** -- A class that strives to apply biblical teachings to everyday, real-life issues. Meetings are discussion-based, and topics vary from week to week, so those who can't attend every Sunday are still able to take part. This informal class is open to anyone post-high school through mid-thirties, and we always welcome new faces!

**3M** -- A class for adults of all ages. The class discusses a variety of topics, all for the purpose of understanding God better. The intent is not so much to teach a particular view, but rather, uses leading questions and class discussion to bring out a variety of ideas on the topic. We go beyond standard questions and answers and delve into the hard questions where there are no easy answers.

**Men's and Women's Class** -- A class that uses a lecture presentation and discussion method, along with the use of chapter books and other bible based reading materials allowing for the use of the Bible (both Old and New Testaments) itself as resource.

**First Sunday Circle** -- For adults of all ages, this group meets on the first Sunday of each month to engage in conversations that help us grow in our faith and share our faith journeys with one another. Currently led by a team of three leaders, the group welcomes new ideas and new participants every month.
